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Research news from Regeneron

It is an exciting time for the global FOP research effort, with USA company Regeneron Pharmaceuticals announcing plans for a clinical trial of their potential drug (REGN2477). Regeneron is the second company to begin clinical trials in FOP, following the commencement of clinical trials of palovarotene by Clementia Pharmaceuticals.

The main aim of this phase II trial is to see if the new drug is safe and tolerable for people with FOP. However the investigators will also collect data on whether it affects the rate of new bone formation, how it affects pain, and how it affects activin A levels and immune function.

Although there are no current plans for this trial to enrol in Australia, FOP Australia are very excited about this new development and look forward to seeing the results in the coming years. Learn more about the trial at https://clinicaltrials.gov/ct2/show/NCT3188666.
